VIRTUS CERTIFICATION

In a continuous effort to protect our children, the parish and school routinely review the VIRTUS certification of its volunteers. VIRTUS training must be recertified every four years by attending a VIRTUS "Keeping the Promise Alive" workshop or by completing the monthly training bulletins available at virtusonline.org. If you have completed forty-eight of the online bulletins, you may be eligible to recertify without attending a live VIRTUS workshop. If your VIRTUS certification expires, you have three months after the expiration date to recertify or you will have to attend a full-length VIRTUS "Protecting God's Children" workshop. Contact the Safeguard the Children Committee at safeguardthechildren@hnmprish.org for more information regarding VIRTUS training and certification.

Holy Name of Mary will be hosting VIRTUS Protecting God's Children workshops throughout the 2016-2017 school year. Anyone who wants to volunteer at the school, with Faith Formation, or with any ministry that works with children must complete this workshop and Live Scan fingerprinting. It is recommended that all parents complete the volunteer process as soon as possible. Certification lasts four (4) years, after which one must be recertified. SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Matthew 5: 20-22a, 2-28, 33-34a, 37

REFLECTING ON THE WORD

In Matthew's account of the Gospel, Jesus continues to teach his closest disciples about the mysteries of the Kingdom of Heaven and about making the right choices. When Jesus says, "Amen," he emphasizes that what he says is the truth, and "I say to you" means that he is the authority on the teaching. As he teaches the disciples, Jesus is taking the old law and reimagining it in the new order. Clearly, the disciples are hearing radically new teaching from the Master.
